**I. Various life circumstances cause people to experience hopelessness.
John 4:18**

A. First of all, she made wrong choices.
V16-15,

B. Second, she repeatedly failed.

C. Third, she may have felt trapped.

D. Finally, she was isolated from her community.

The results of the array of attacks isolated her. She felt dirty, down cast, Destroyed.
