Introduction:

I. Warning Never Forget God v.11a

- a. We should never need to be reminded to give God praise and thanks
- b. God doesn't like to be taken for granted
Lev 26:14-16

II. Evidence of Our Remembrance v.11b

- a. Should be seen in how we live
- b. Keeping His commands, His laws and decrees
- c. We are created to praise Him Isa 43:21

III. Getting Caught Up In The Blessings vs 12-13

- a. God blesses us to encourage us not distract us
- b. When we get caught up in the blessings we forget to give thanks unto the Lord
- c. Every good and perfect gift comes from Him James 1:17

IV. It Is All God and Always Will Be v.14

- a. We are wrong when we get puffed up in pride thinking we did something Deut 8:18
- b. We just need to remember Who it was that freed us from the bonds of Sin
- c. We should give God thanks in all circumstances 1 Thess 5:18

V. It Is God Who Brings Us Through v.15

- a. God is always present in our trials and tribulations Ps 46:1-2

VI. God Provides All Our Needs v.16

- a. The manna was to teach them to depend on God daily
- b. The land can't provide all our needs
- c. God humbles us to lead us to depend on Him
- d. God has promised to meet all our needs Phil 4:19
